

GRAN CANARIA – SCHEDULE OF EXCURSIONS

SATURDAY – ISLAND TOUR - AROUND THE ISLAND adult = 29 euros child = 19 euros (FULL DAY)

All 4 coasts in just one day.irst heading south-west to Puerto de Mogan then heading up the west coast, visiting San Nicolas farming region and valleys and on to Agaete. From there we head along the north coast passing through Galdar, Guia & Arucas stopping in Las Palmas city stopping in the Las Canteras coast area. Finally heading back south down the motorway.

SATURDAY – CANARIAN NIGHT adult = 40 euros child = 20 euros (EVENING – **DINNER INCLUDED**)

We will start the evening travelling to the Barranco of Guayadeque to visit first the “Ermita” (cave church) and an inhabited cave house. Afterwards, we will have our evening meal in the cave restaurant next to the Ermita. As part of the evening there’s a cooking demonstration where we’ll learn how to make “Pella de Gofio” and Mojo Canario”, next is music whilst sampling tapas and Sangria. For the meal the starter is Canarian Soup or Salad, main course is oven-cooked meat in sauce or chicken and fruit for desert. Wine and soft drinks are also included. The evening finishes around 10:30pm.

SUNDAY – A TASTE OF GRAN CANARIA adult = 37 euros child = 18,50 euros (HALF DAY – **LUNCH INCLUDED**)

First stop after heading north is the Villa de Ingenio where we will visit the Plaza de la Candelaria and walk through the historic streets with Canarian houses, the Nestor Park and to see the incredible mosaic. After, we head towards the center of the island via the Barranco of Guayadeque, visiting the “Ermita” (cave church) and the other caves in the village. We’ll have a traditional Canarian “tapa” lunch (included in the price) in a cave bar before going to the Guayadeque Museum (included in the price).

SUNDAY – MARKET DAY adult = 19 euros child = 15 euros (FULL DAY)

Visit the two largest, most traditional craft markets on the island, away from the touristy gimmicks and souvenirs to more traditional Canarian products. First to the beautiful town of Teror and afterwards to it’s neighbour San Mateo.

TUESDAY & THURDAY – LORO PARQUE IN TENERIFE adult = 79 euros child = 55 euros (FULL DAY)

Loro Parque is a world-famous adventure where you’ll be transported to the owlrd of the animals thanks to the magnificent representation of their habitats such as a snowing antartic enclosure for the penguins or the “bat cave”. Don’t miss the shows from the Killer Whales, the Sea Lions, the Parrots and the Dolphins.

WEDNESDAY – SHOPPING !! adult = 21 euros child = 10.50 euros (HALF DAY)

The day starts with two hours free time at San Fernando/Maspalomas market. From there we head north up the motorway to Vecindario and to the huge Atlantico Shopping Center where there's 2 hours free time to wander round the wide choice of shops (including Carrefour hypermarket), and cafes before returning to the hotels at approx. 2pm.

THURSDAY – GRAN CANARIA HIGHLIGHTS adult = 29 euros child = 19 euros (FULL DAY)

Heading north up the east coast through Telde to Arucas where we stop to visit the historic quarter, spectacular church and the famous rum distillery with the biggest vaults in Europe (with tasting of course!) Heading up to the center of the island with stops for panoramic views of Las Palmas city next stop is the typical and beautiful Canarian town of Teror with it's whitewashed stone buildings with wooden roofs and balconies. From there through the countryside to the very center of the island and the rock formations at Roque Nublo. From there down through the Almond groves and San Bartolome and the canyons back down to the south.

FRIDAY – PUERTO DE MOGAN MARKET & VILLAGE adult = 15 euros child = 10 euros (HALF DAY)

Visit the little Venice of Gran Canaria, one of the most picturesque villages on the island with canals, bouganvillea-lined streets and on Friday a large market. From there we visit the old village and valley of Mogan, 6 km away from the Puerto.

FRIDAY NIGHT – SIOUX CITY adult = 55 euros child = 25 euros (EVENING)

First part of the evening is free time around the wild-west town to explore the streets, the stores, the animals (avoid the cattle stampede) and free bar in the saloon. After a BBQ the main show starts with cowboys, Indians, horse-riding tricks, knife throwing, lasso tricks any wild-west tricks and shows you can think of, I'm sure you'll experience it at Sioux City.

DAILY – BOAT CRUISE adult = 48 euros child = 25 euros (FULL DAY)

Set sail aboard a sunseeker cruiser sailing out to sea first to search for the dolphins then back to shore a little to cruise the south west coast, passing the resorts, beaches and the sea caves along the way. Free time for snorkelling and banana boat ride. All included as is lunch and free bar.

DAILY – JEEP SAFARI adult = 47 euros child = 26 euros (FULL DAY)

An island tour with a difference and a great way to see the countryside and some of the southern Canarian culture, by open-top jeep. Travel through the canyons of the south, some of the villages, off-road through the pine forests and down to one of the reservoirs (free time for swimming). Lunch included.

DAILY - BUGGY SAFARI solo = 99 euros 2 sharing = 120 euros (no kids & driving license required)

Drive yourself through the mountains and countryside of the south by buggy, both on and off-road.

DAILY - SPORTS FISHING adult = 65 euros child = 50 euros (FULL DAY)

DAILY – HORSE RIDING - Trecking through the Canarian mountains and forests by horse.

BEGINNERS – 2 HOURS adult = 59 euros child = 59 euros

ADVANCED – 3 HOURS adult = 69 euros child = 69 euros

DAILY - HELICOPTER RIDE (prices per adult/child though infants 2 and under travel free)

10 MINUTES OVER PLAYA DEL INGLES, MASPALOMAS & THE SAND DUNES 80 euros

20 MINUTES AS ABOVE & THROUGH THE MOUNTAINS TO SAN BARTOLOME 130 euros

30 MINUTES AS ABOVE TO THE VERY CENTER, TEJEDA & BACK VIA MOGAN 179 euros

DAILY – SWIM WITH THE SEALIONS

Adults - €45 euros Children 8 yrs and under - €40 euros (2-hour session includes orientation)

You will be able to stroke the Sea Lions as they fly past you in the water, give and receive a sea lion kiss, see them jump over you as you hold a hurdle bar over your head, and get a warm sea lion hug. They have a great sense of humour and love the mimic people, so be prepared to laugh while participating in this program!
